The Field Innovation Team (FIT) will walk participants through the Three Step Prep creating solutions in REAL-TIME demonstrating how innovation, fast prototyping, and agile teams have been deployed by FIT and our partners in global disasters. The lessons learned have exponential impact for current and future leaders. Join us for high intensity and explosive creativity at the Do Tank, for the intersection of innovation,
